

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THE SCREEN ACTOR 6



The Screen Actor + Filmmaker is the only 40 week program in Australia that arms the aspiring young actor with the tools to shape a professional career within the screen and filmmaking industries.

You will travel on a deep journey through mastering your connection to the truth of the moment in front of and behind the camera while building real world connections way beyond the classroom. You will learn how to analyse scenes, connect to your inner power and tune into the other actor through performing scenes from our library of scripts specifically written for your age range.

You will shoot showreel scenes throughout some of Sydney's most iconic locations and upload them to your online profile to showcase your journey to the world, your agent and your family.

Our team of coaches are trained to inspire you every step of the way and through working with our original YAA syllabus, you will unveil a brave, skilful and intelligent approach towards the craft of acting. As the journey continues, you will travel with your cast and a team of industry leaders who will empower you to bring your script to the screen.





Classes capped at 16 actors



Alexandria Waterloo Surry Hills Working on a film set is every young actor's dream and over the September School Holidays you will work with a professional crew of filmmakers and act up a storm in your own short film over 3 full 10-hour shoot days. At the end of the year, you will proudly walk the red carpet alongside your castmates and celebrate your achievements with family and industry guests at our end-of-year Young Actors Awards cinema showcase.

Prep Week - 'The Call To Adventure

7 days prior to course commencement you will receive a link to assemble online where you will be introduced to your core group of actors to prepare you for the journey ahead. This is where you will meet your coaches and YAA Ambassadors who have been handpicked to welcome you to our brand-new world. You will receive a copy of 'Unshakeable Actors Manual' - an inspiring 30-page goal-setting and class companion written to accompany your weekly lessons and get ready for a journey of a lifetime.

THEJOURNEY

Your Term 1 journey is shaped to propel you straight into the structure of storytelling and the craft of acting by getting you up on your feet and practising.

Before working within and learning about the camera frame, you are taught how to use your whole instrument by connecting to your body, your voice, your heart and the language of your face. You will learn how to analyse scenes, how to connect to your breath and how to tune into the other actor through performing scenes that are written for YAA actors every single year. Shooting scenes 'on location' will give you that leading edge and your footage will be uploaded to your online profile to view at home.

You will prepare mini-tasks at home which you will perform in class and gain a deeper understanding of the industry and your place within it. As the term progresses you will begin to form positive working habits building you into a brave, skilful and intelligent young leader.





THECRAFT

You will journey with leading coaches, meet industry guests, learn original acting exercises and become empowered to take risks by making the acting process your weekly habit.

Learning to positively critique your own work is an important tool for every young actor and through working in a fun and inspiring environment you and your classmates will celebrate your achievements so far. In week 6 you will start the 'Creative Practice' journey where you will be taught skills on how to prepare you for your filmmaking adventure.

Our YAA Screenwriters Bootcamp is a groundbreaking two-day immersion into the life of the writer. Over 2 full days, you will work with a team of screenwriting coaches to dissect and reveal a compelling story by the end of the workshop. You will pitch your idea to the studio and be in the running to bring your story to the cinema screen.



Over the next 10 weeks you will demonstrate an authentic voice through producing your own short 30 minute film for the cinema screen and learn how to enhance your creative skills through pitching your story to your cast and work with industry coaches to deliver your final draft ready to shoot over 5 exciting weeks.

Our team will guide you along your hero's journey and you will be educated in the disciplines of screenwriting, directing, cinematography, sound, editing, production, and production design. Each cast will be taught how to utilise industry standard preproduction software and allocate crew roles to get your film on its feet.

As the weeks roll on, your knowledge of the filmmaking process will deepen and you will be introduced to a world of professional directors, gaffers, sound operators, 1st AD's, director of photographers and editors who will teach you how to use (and respect) the professional equipment and software.

Over 3 full days you will act up a storm on location in your very own film and gain a comprehensive understanding of essential filmmaking principles.



WHATS INVOLVED?

TThe YAA Filmmaker Module offers your child a range of resources they can take into their future acting or filmmaking careers. From meeting a professional crew of filmmakers who have been handpicked for their talent and expertise, to new screen acting skills, to pre-production experience, they will gain a complete understanding and appreciation of the industry. We are determined to offer students an experience that replicates the professional world of Film & Television.

THE DEVELOPMENT PHASE (TERM 2 WEEK 7,8)

Creative Practice Weeks - exploring collaborative team-building skills to prepare them for the journey ahead students are taught to builds trust and respect for the process and each other. These are fun packed sessions.

THE DEVELOPMENT PHASE (TERM 2 WEEK 9,10)

The two-day Writers Bootcamp + The Production Workshop (1 day). We give our filmmakers the option to attend one of two workshops to initiate the Filmmaking process. We bring in Industry professionals to guide the students in both Screenwriting & PreProduction. From this, our writers and production managers for each film are born.

THE PRE-PRODUCTION PHASE - WEEK 1-10

Pre-production comes early in the filmmaking process, after development and before production. It involves finalising the script, casting the actors, hiring crew, location scouting, applying for insurances, determining what equipment we will need, and figuring out the budget. It is the planning stage of a film, where we solidify all the details of each project before producing content.

- Membership to Studiobinder industry standard pre production software.
- Membership to Artlist.io Sound Studio.
- Membership to Zoom for meetings with key crew members.
- Pre production workshops with Tertiary Film Students.
- Mentorship from graduate directors, coaches and industry professionals.
- Learning the ropes of crowdsourcing.

THE PRODUCTION PHASE (FILM SHOOT 3 DAYS ON SET)

Professional crews are hired including:

- Director.
- 1st Assistant Director (1st AD)
- Director of Photography (DoP)
- 1st Assistant Camera (1st AC)
- Gaffer
- Sound
- BTS Videography / Photography

Equipment is hired to ensure the product is of an exceptional standard.

POST PRODUCTION

The work continues behind the scenes throughout Term 4. While the students get back to filming their weekly classes, our team continues

to juggle the post production process. This includes:

- 2 months of editing
- Colour grading
- Sound design
- Music rights
- Foley
- DCP file formatting to showcase films on the cinema screen
- Film poster design
- Marketing & PR





THEPACKAGE

Every hero returns from their journey changed for the better. At the start of the term we will collectively celebrate your hard work and bring your experience to our Young Actors roundtable.

Behind the scenes your film will be deep in the editing process and you and your cast will work together to plan and build a marketing package to promote it to the world. Our Young Actors Business Bootcamp will give you the insight to market yourself online in a social media driven world, taking a deep dive into your branding, PR, personal marketing, and talking to the media in preparation for your red carpet debut at the Young Actors Awards in December.

YAAAWARDS

At Young Actors Assembly our mission is to not only build professional young actors, but to unveil critical thinkers who stay curious about the world.

In December each year, the films will be showcased at the cinema to an audience of industry professionals, families and friends at our end of year Young Actors Awards Showcase.

On this night we celebrate the collective effort of what makes us human on screen, but most importantly, we celebrate an assembly of courageous young people.

Your child will also receive an IMDB credit for both their on screen and crew roles.

We are proud of the partnerships that we have made to make this night a success each and every year. They include local businesses and industry leaders who know the value of what we do.


















STAGE1

You will develop optimum skills and connect your authentic self to the work by choosing scenes from our library of over 800 plays every week. You will learn an analysis process based on four simple principles and begin to live moment to moment through original exercises to bring back each week.

Over the weeks you will build a solid working relationship with one another which will shape you into a disciplined and courageous human being. The class is dissected into 3 key elements:

The Human Condition (you), Script Analysis & Performance Technique.





STAGE2

This is an invitation to re-awaken your relationship to your actors life in a profoundly personal journey.

Over the 10 weeks you will explore different techniques and work together to unlock the obstacles which have held you back for far too long. Armed with your newfound knowledge from Stage 1 you will experience exercises which include mindset, breath work, moment lab, focus, tension, rhythm, space and language. You will utilise these tools to reveal inner strength, a deeper intelligence and a newfound connection to yourself and your character.

Each week we channel your experience through script work and performance technique.





We start the term reading our chosen play and begin the job of allocating our cast. This term is shaped to give you the opportunity to work on text in a professional setting where your director will give feedback in a professional and exciting environment. Each week we will work together to unveil the story moment by moment and you will be given specific exercises which will bring your character to life.

You will be introduced to an assembly of theatre practitioners who include professional lighting and set designers and begin to work together to create your masterpiece for your audience.

Students will also learn about producing and create their own press releases to get their audience motivated to attend opening night.




STAGE4






No Road to Neom



Tongue Tied (2020)








